Program Highlights:

• Community Health & Engagement

Since July, the Community Health & Engagement team has worked tirelessly to connect families with essential resources and increase access to health education. From large-scale events like FamFest and Harvest Fest to specialized programs like Mommy & Me and the 'Can We Talk!' HIV/AIDS Awareness Series, our outreach has empowered over 1,200 residents through education, prevention, and community connection.

• Behavioral Health Services

The Behavioral Health Department expanded its reach through trauma-informed training, community workshops, and stronger partnerships with local schools and universities. The team continues to provide compassionate, evidence-based support that promotes emotional wellness for children and families.

• Medical & Dental Clinic

Our Integrated Health Clinic has served over 500 patients since July, providing preventive care, dental services, and behavioral health support under one roof. Walk-in availability and extended service hours have improved accessibility for families with urgent needs.

• Foster Care & Family Services

The Foster Care team continues to recruit, train, and support dedicated foster parents throughout the community. Through collaboration with churches and local agencies, CFCE has strengthened its foster parent network and improved outcomes for children in care.

Community in Action:

From July through November, CFCE hosted impactful events that strengthened family engagement, community partnerships, and awareness of our programs and services.

• FamFest 2025 – Back-to-School Health & Wellness Fair

CFCE distributed over 350 bookbags, provided free screenings, and connected 200+ families to health and social services. The event expanded partnerships with 25 vendors and sponsors, reinforcing our commitment to family wellness.

• Community Partners Luncheon – 'Faith in Action' Series

• Community Partners Luncheon – Virtual Mission Series

Over 20 faith-based and nonprofit leaders gathered to discuss health equity, behavioral health awareness, and community collaboration. The luncheon fostered stronger partnerships and alignment with CFCE's mission.

• CFCE Town Hall – 'Voices of Impact'

Staff, leadership, and board members came together for updates, recognition, and discussion on agency priorities. Dr. Mays emphasized CFCE's ongoing commitment to quality service and organizational growth.

• Magnolia Park Food Distributions

Monthly food distributions served more than 250 families with fresh groceries, hygiene supplies, and on-site benefit support. These events strengthened CFCE's visibility and connections with local residents.
